CURRICULA CHANGES FOR '77

MEDIA TECHNOLOGY

The media technology curriculum is designed to provide two years study resulting in an Associate of Science degree. Program emphasis is upon the skilled operation of media production equipment used in television studios, and graduates are able to operate educational media programs. Current plans include a film production of media technology students and a show that focuses on campus activities.





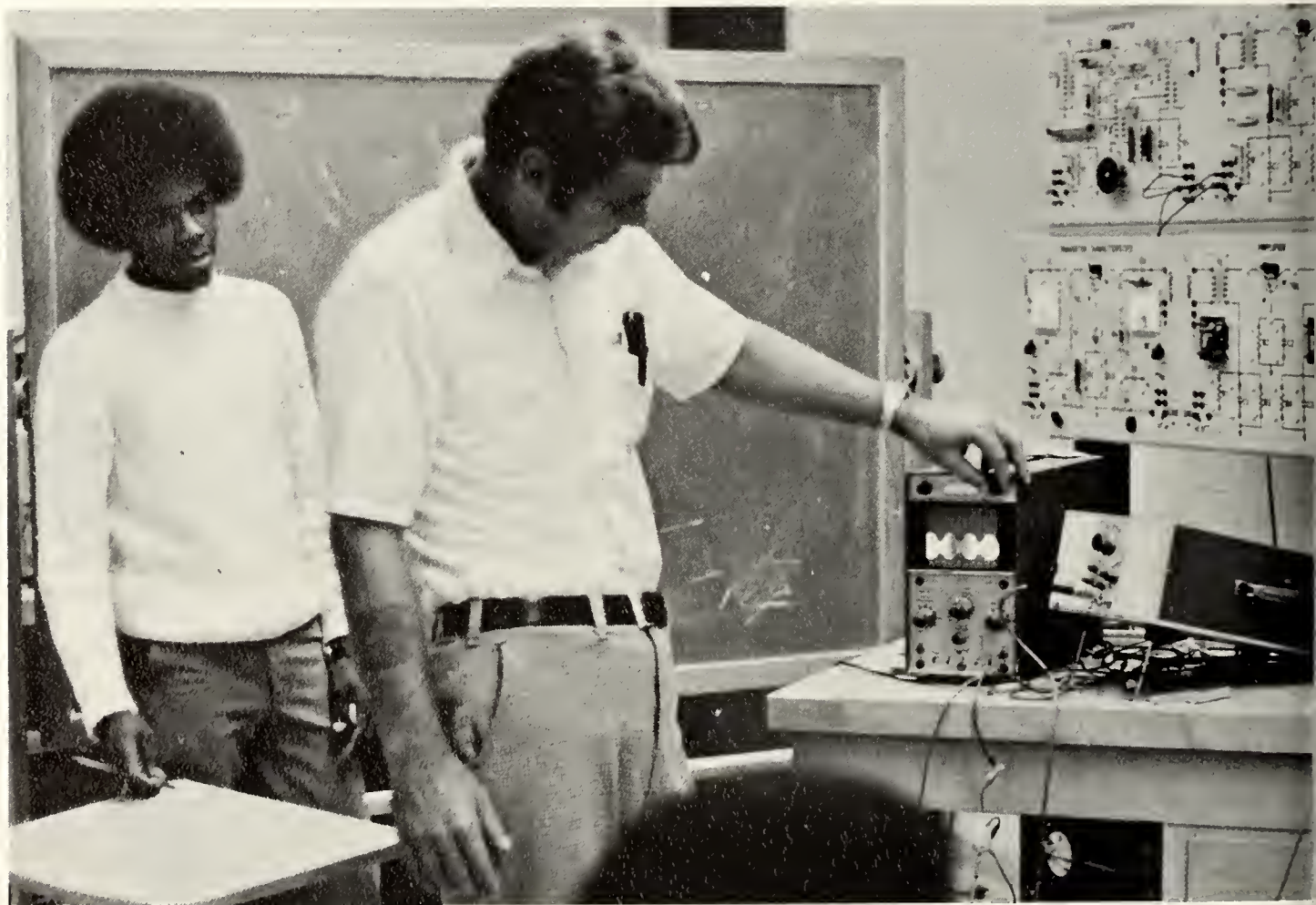
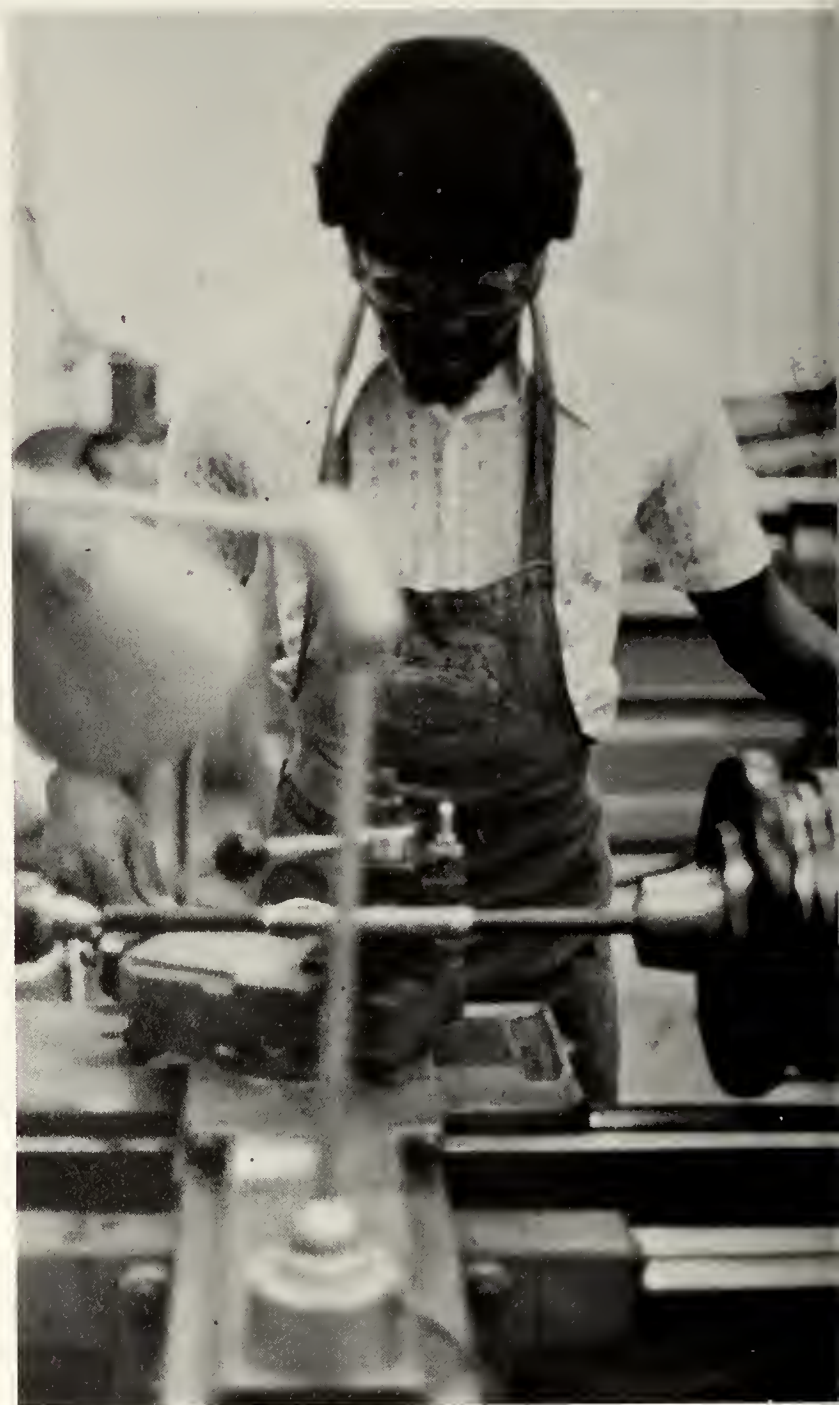
ART

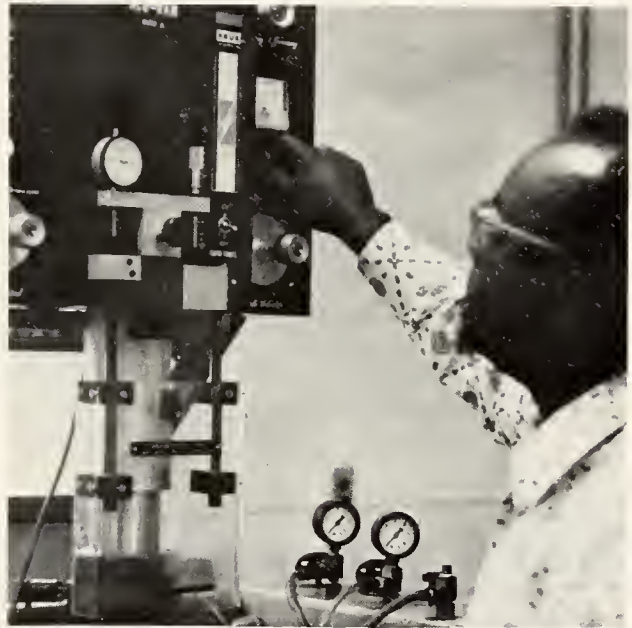
The art curriculum provides a means for development of one's visual perception through course offerings in drawing and design. Studio courses are designed for personal exploration in a variety of art media. Students electing to major in art at Utica may complete the first two years of art prerequisites leading to a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree.



VOC-TECH ENROLLMENT INCREASES

Current enrollment figures in the Voc-Tech areas reach in excess of seven hundred—reflecting the high student interest in job oriented education. The college's Vocational-Technical Division has grown from an initial ten programs to the current eighteen—including the new Media Technology program. Graduating Uticanites are assisted readily in the search for employment by the division's placement office.



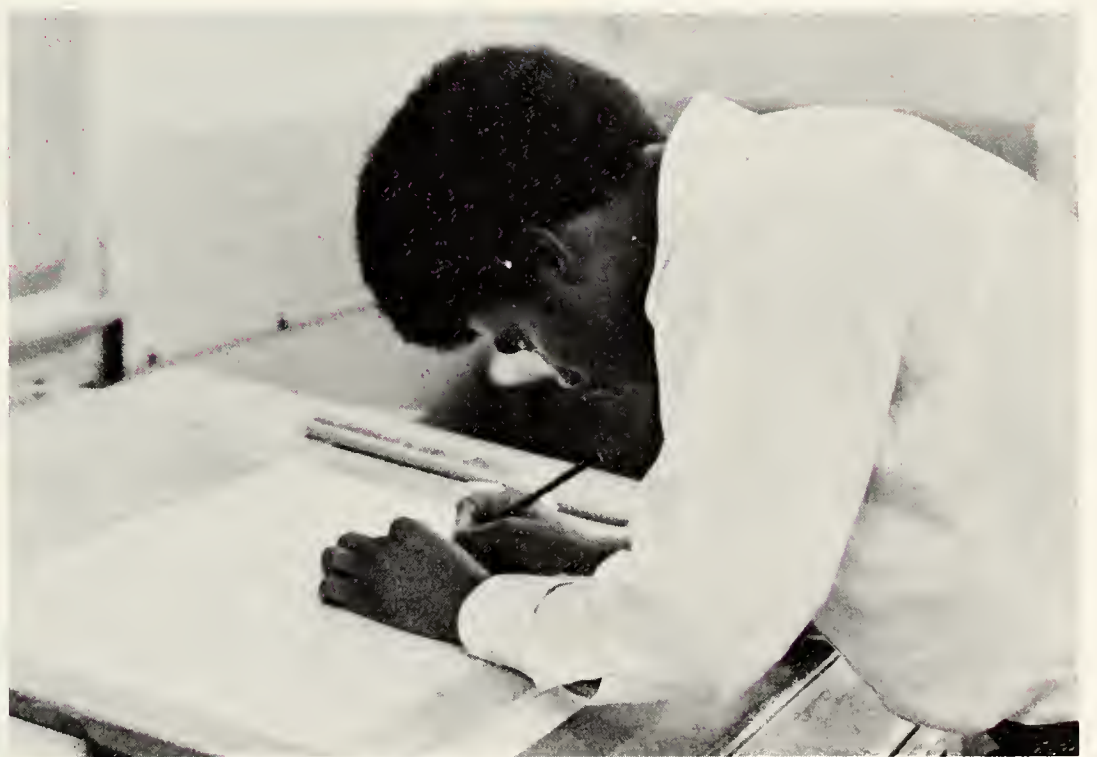


COMPETENCY PROGRAMS ARRIVE

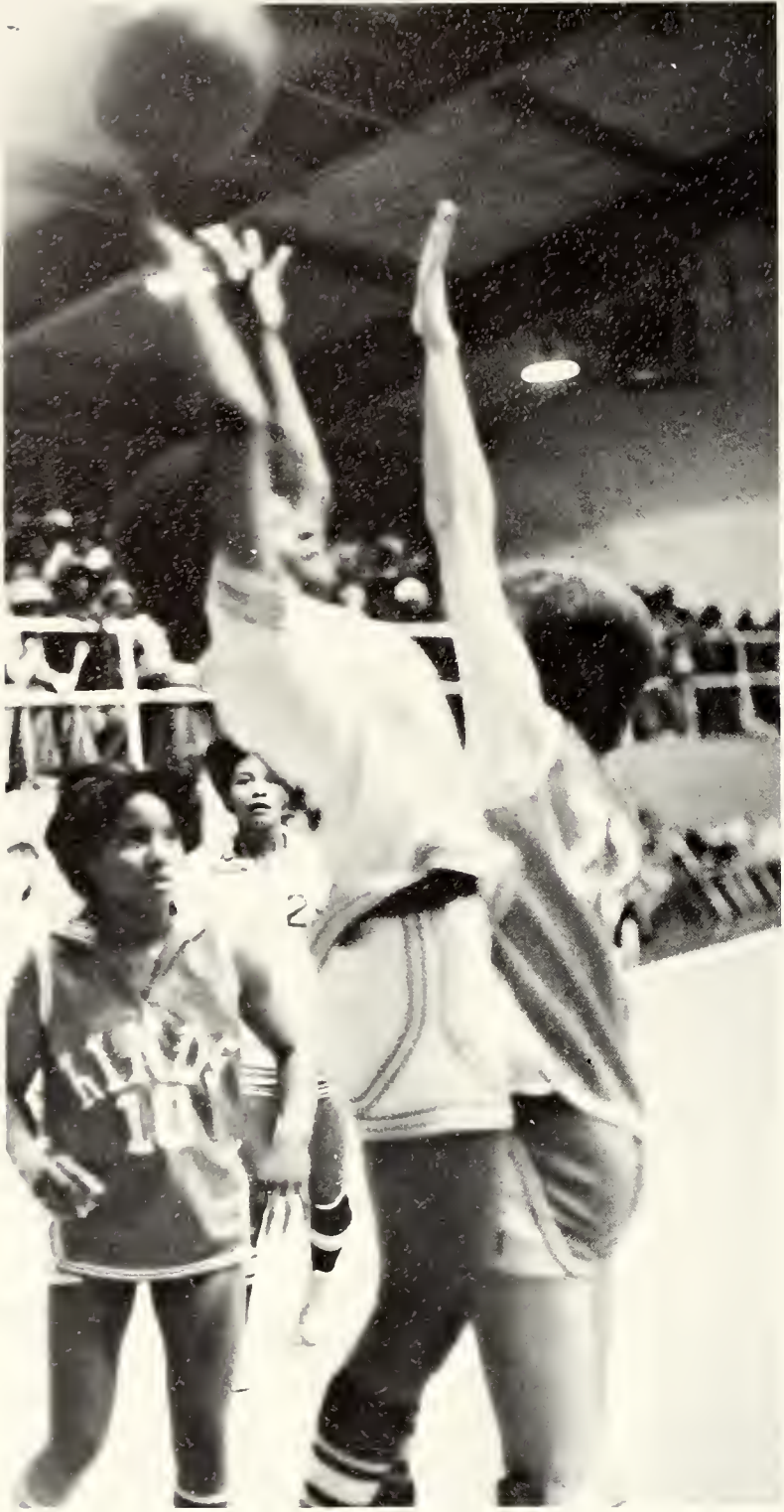


PROGRESS AND PHYSICAL CHANGE

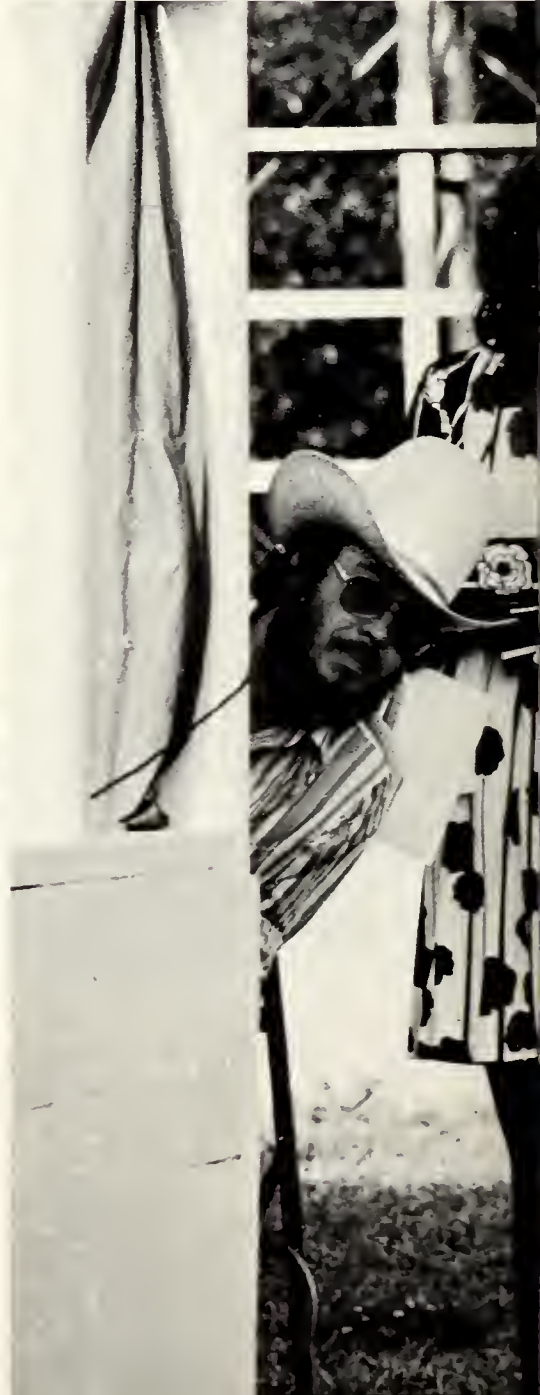

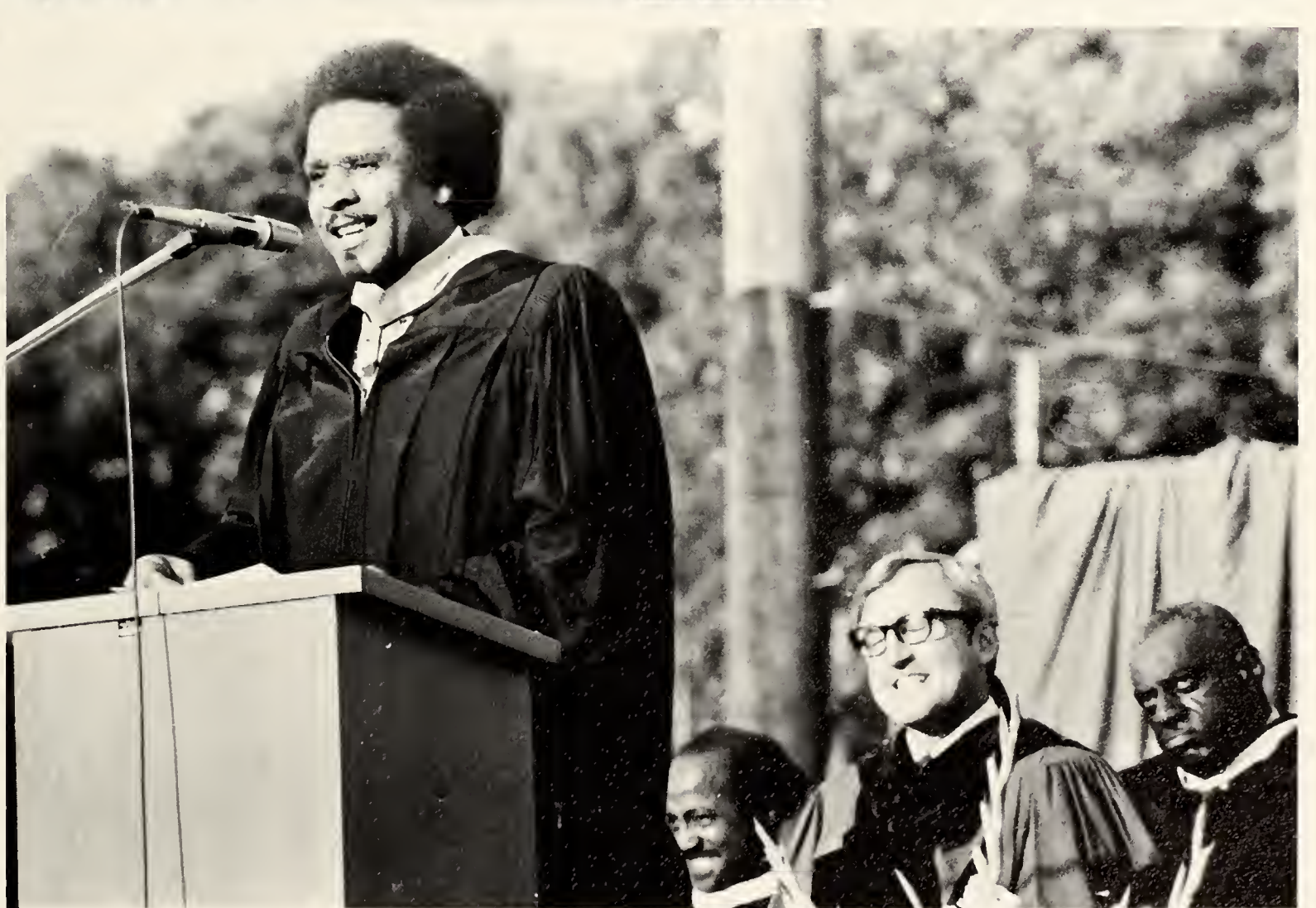
