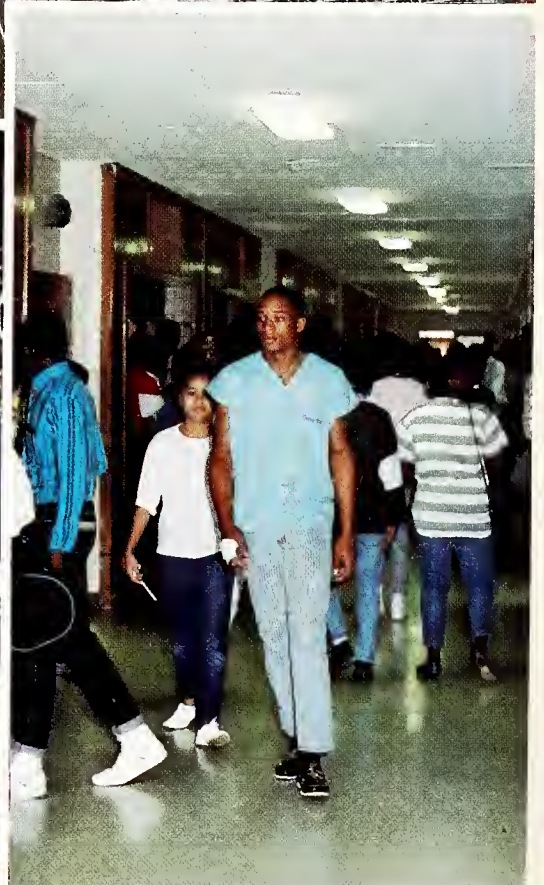
TODAY . . . TOMORROW . . .

Homecoming Extravaganza . . .

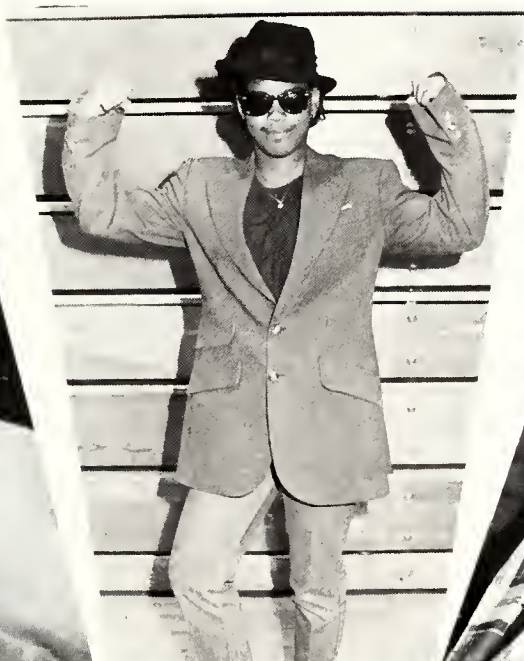
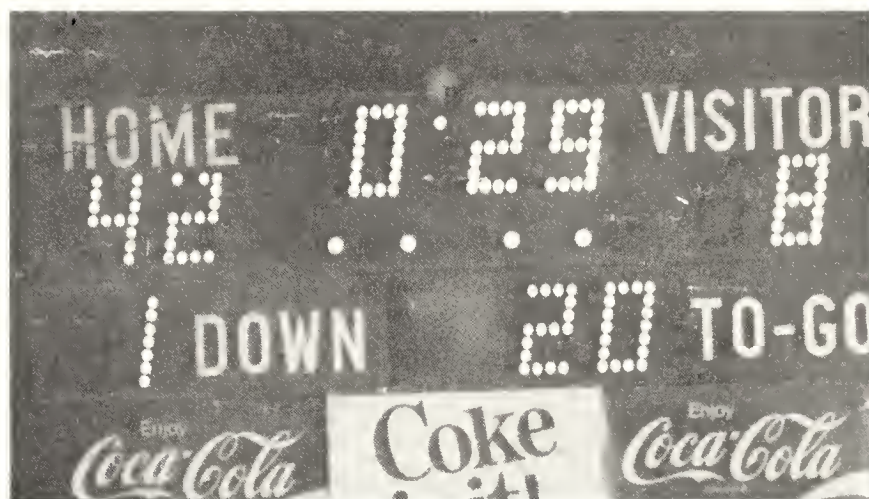
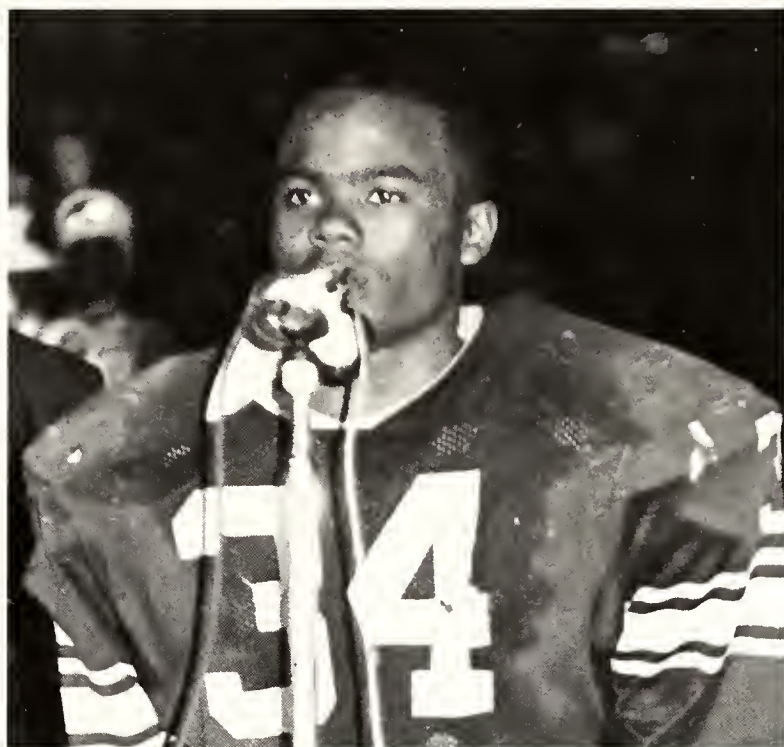

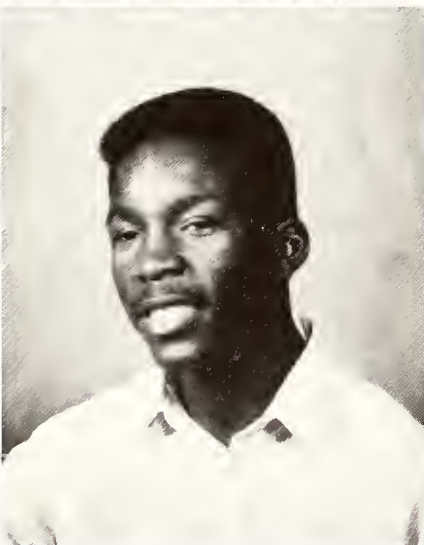
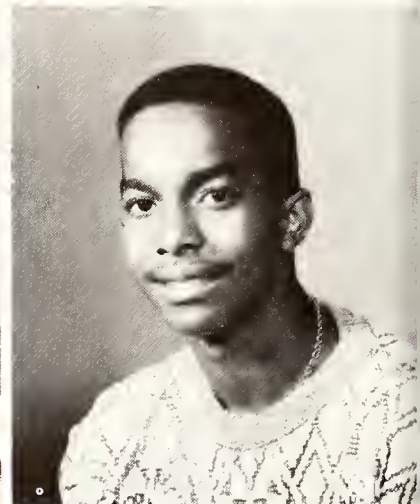
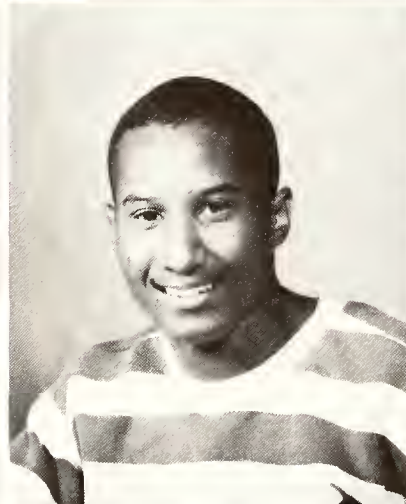
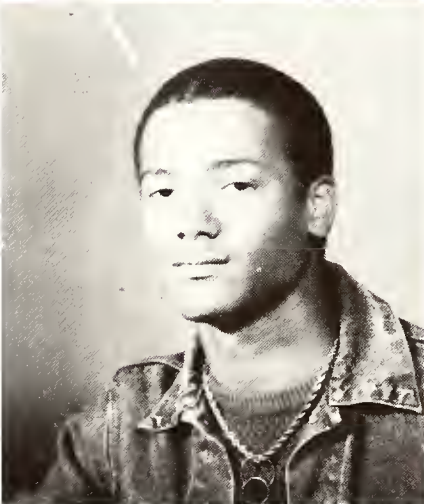
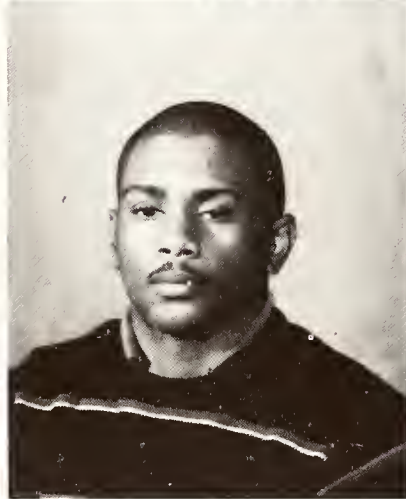
"Slops"
