As we dwell on them, we start to cry.

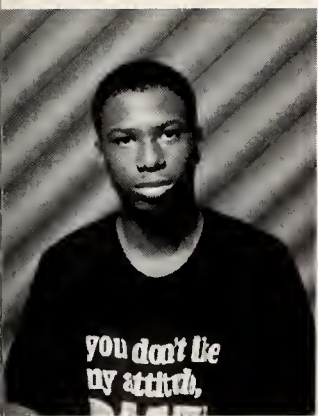
