

Hinds AHS incorporated Senate Bill #2239 into her disciplinary procedures, started developing a School Improvement Plan, raised her graduation requirements from twenty (20) to twenty-three (23) Carnegie Units, utilized Cyberstar and Plato as means of improving academic achievement, updated the Technology Plan, and broke with many of the traditional practices in the classrooms. 


