Jeremy Wilson is a native of Utica, Mississippi. He is the proud son of Ms. Gloria Wilson.

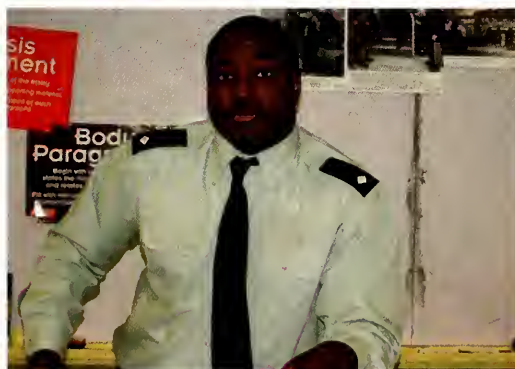
Jeremy is a four-year member of the Wardawg Football Team, on which he plays the position of guard.

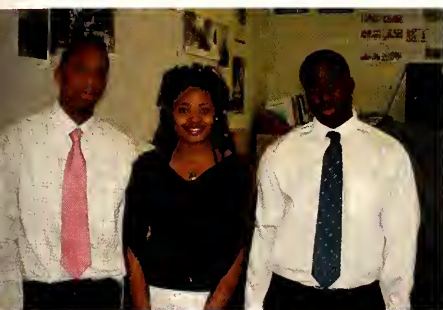


Celebrating Black History Month
