> As Juniors we were assigned a tedious job It was out obligation to plan the prom We put our heads together and worked diligently Then hosted the best prom in Hinds AHS history


Finally we are the honored Senior Class Our time is nearly spent; our days have passed fast We will remember our high school years forever The friends we made, and special moments together
