





The President And The First Lady






In the fall of 1957 there came to the campus of Utica Junior College a person destined to play a dynamic role in the history of the institution.




HISTORY OF BULLPUPS


The need to increase co-curricular activites for high school students resulted in the organization of a basketball team. The team was initially organized as an intramural activity. Because of the popularity the team experienced during the first semester of the first year, the powerful band of players quickly moved into competitive games with surrounding high school adversaries. Thus, the first year ended with a record of 12 wins and 9 losses with Mr. Robert Cowherd serving as coach. The second year, 1964-65, marked the beginning of a series of successful years with the following seasonal records: 1964-65—30 wins and l loss; 1965-66--17 wins and 2 losses; 1966-67--22 wins and 2 losses and 1967-68 the Bullpups proved more than a match for all opponents and closed the season with an unblemished record of 22 wins and 0 losses. Through the years the team has enjoyed the enthusiastic support of the entire faculty and student body. The Bullpups, presently coached by Mr. Joseph Nelson, anticipate continued success.
