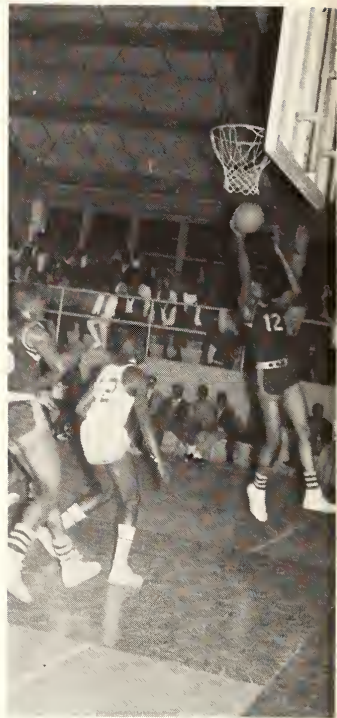


HISTORY OF BULLPUPS
