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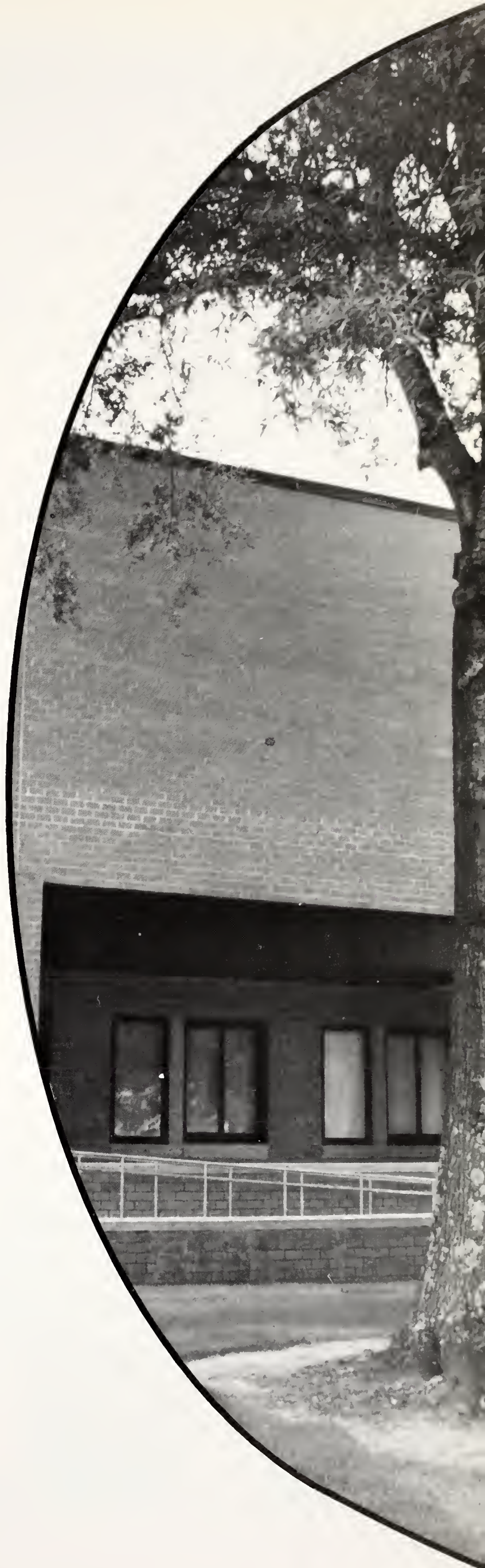
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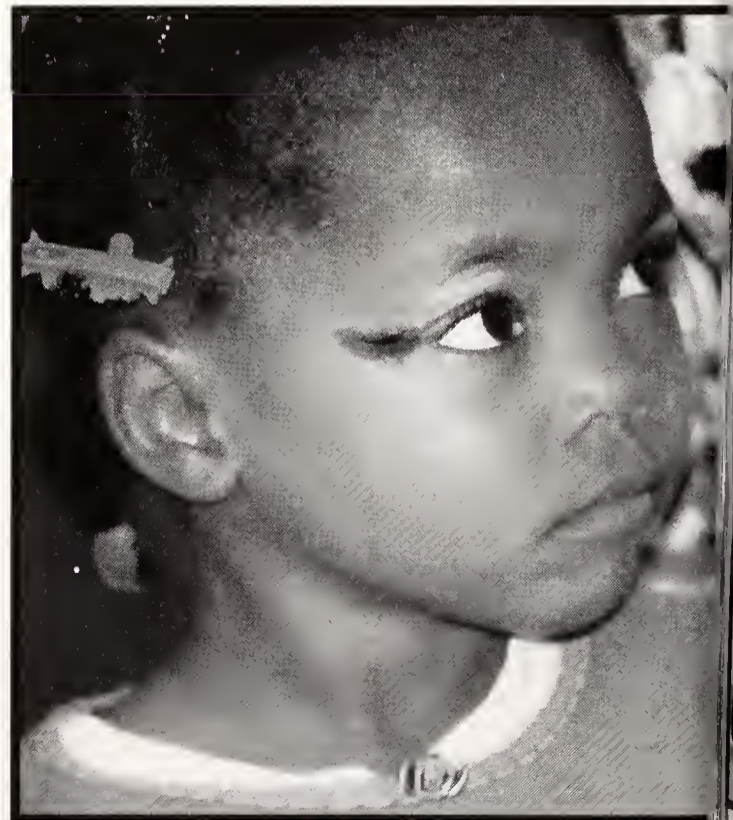
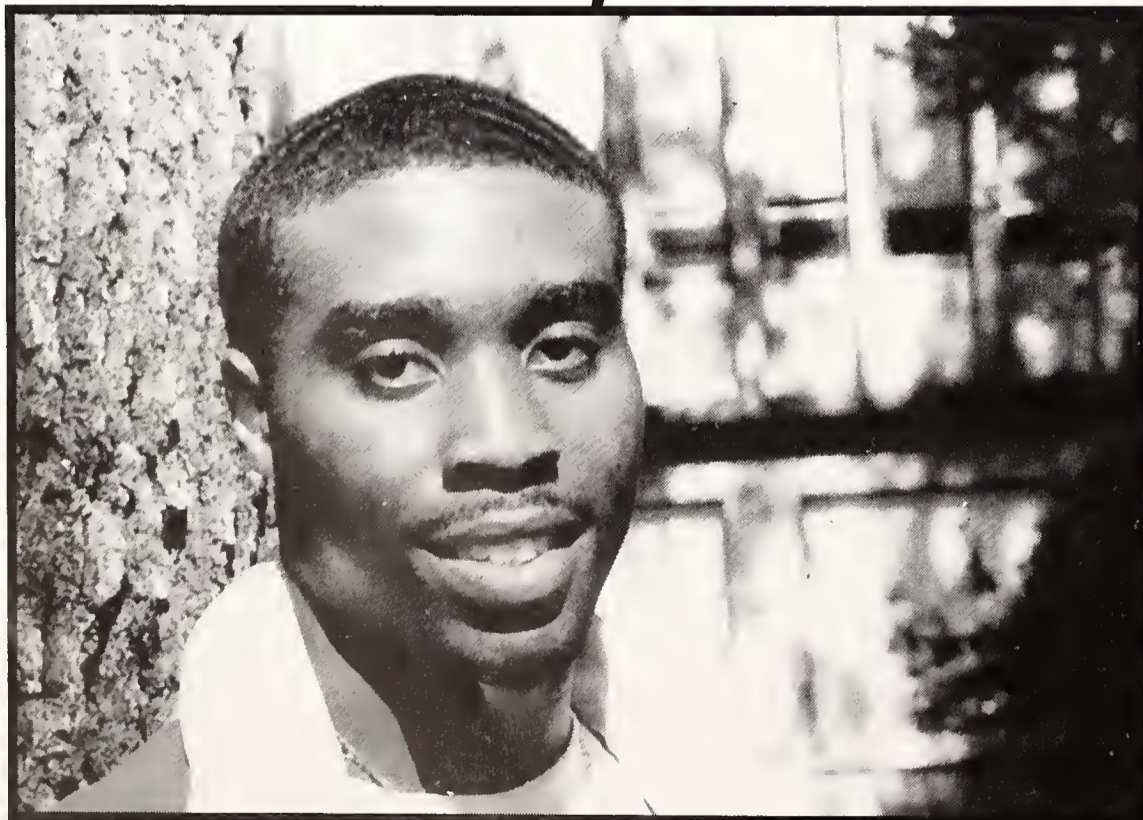
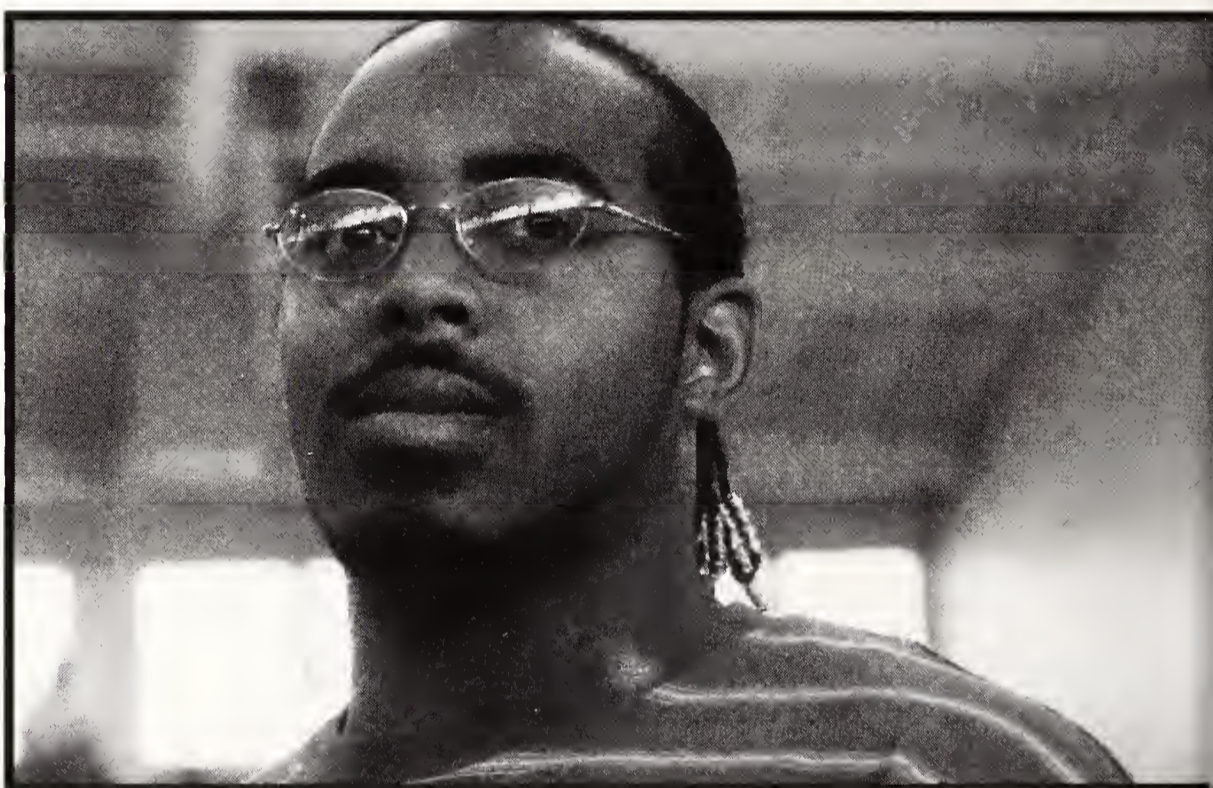
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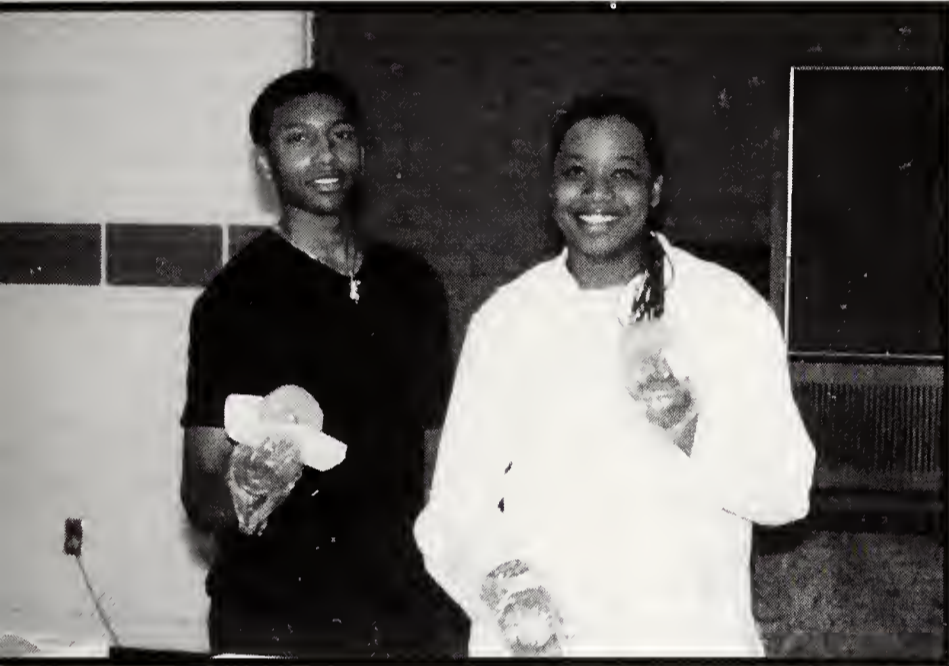


# The Ulticanite Family Welcomes You Home

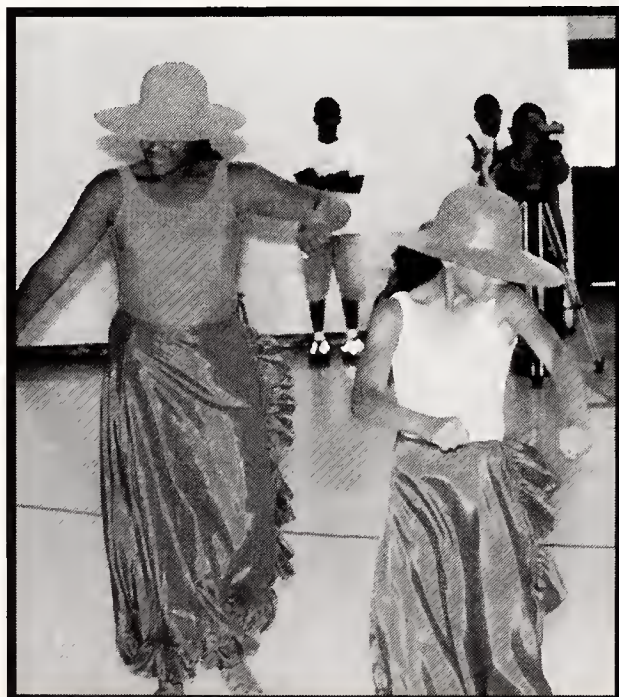


## Mahogany Dancers

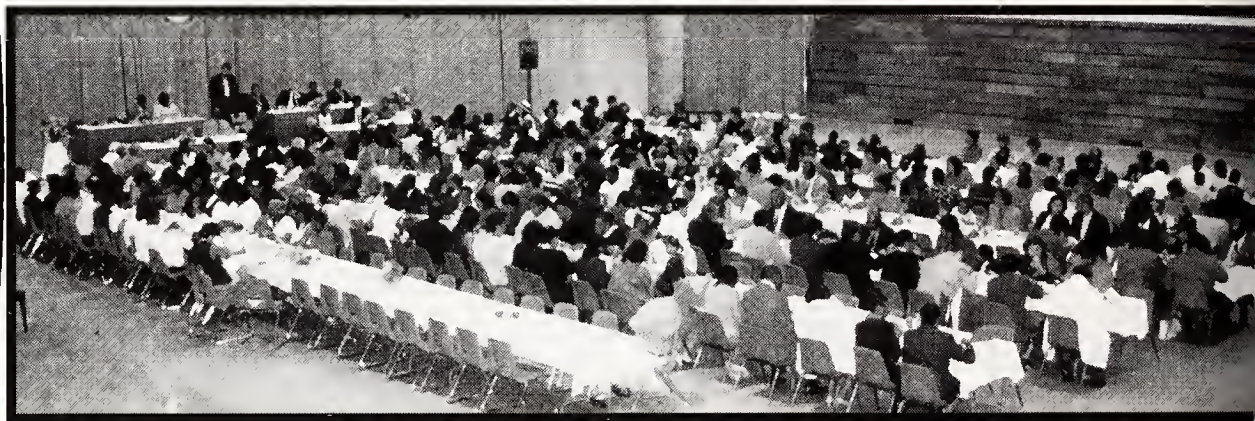
# Thanksgiving Dinner 2001
